PRAYING FOR HIS SALVATION

2 Kings 6:17:

And Elisha prayed, "Open his eyes, LORD, so that he may see." Then the LORD opened the servant's eyes, and he looked and saw the hills full of horses and chariots of fire all around Elisha.

Prayer: Lord, open _____ eyes so that he may see you.

Ecclesiastes 3:11:

PRAYING FOR HIS ROLE AS HUSBAND AND FATHER

Ephesians 5:25, 28

Husbands, love your wives, just as Christ loved the church and gave himself up for her.

In this same way, husbands ought to love their wives as their own bodies. He who loves his wife loves himself.

Prayer: Lord Jesus, help _____ to love me as you call all husbands to love their wives. Help him to see that we are better together, working in unity, under Christ, to care for each other and our children.

Psalms 25:4-5

PRAYING FOR HIS ROLE AS PROVIDER (AND FOR HIS WORKPLACE)

Proverbs 11:3

The integrity of the upright guides them, but the unfaithful are destroyed by their duplicity.

Prayer: Lord, help _____ to be a man of integrity. Put Godly men around him to model what that looks like. Steer him away from compromising choices and when faced with one, give him the wisdom he needs to make the right decision.

Matthew 6:19-21

But store up for yourselves treasures in heaven, where moth and rust do not destroy, and where thieves do not break in and steal. For where your treasure is, there your heart will be also.”

Prayer: Lord, I pray that you would help _____ to be a wise steward of our money. Don't let him become so driven and consumed with money that he forgets who and what he is working for. Help him keep his priorities straight and remind him continuously that his true treasure is at home with his family. And prepare his heart for you, Jesus, for you are our greatest treasure of all.

Isaiah 40:31

But those who hope in the LORD will renew their strength. They will soar on wings like eagles; they will run and not grow weary, they will walk and not be faint.

Prayer: Lord, I place my hope in you. Renew my strength. When I grow weary, remind me to refocus my thoughts and hope in you because they have shifted to my circumstances. With you, Lord Jesus, I know I will not only persevere but have joy in each and every day. Thank you!

Ephesians 5:33

However, each one of you also must love his wife as he loves himself, and the wife must respect her husband.

Prayer: Precious Lord, reveal to me areas where I am not respecting my husband. Show me how I can change so that my words and actions will affirm my husband and don't tear him down. Help me to be the wife you desire me to be.



Romans 8:28

And we know that in all things God works for the good of those who love him, who have been called according to his purpose.

Prayer: Father God, thank you so much for working for my good. Thank you for using all the circumstances in my life—good and bad—to strengthen my faith and to bring me closer to you in our relationship. Lord, you are not only the redeemer of our lives, but also the redeemer of our circumstances. I praise you for each and every victory and give you all the glory.

2 Corinthians 2:14-16

But thanks be to God, who always leads us in triumphal procession in Christ and through us spreads everywhere the fragrance of the knowledge of him. For we are to God the aroma of Christ among those who are being saved and those who are perishing. To the one we are the smell of death; to the other, the fragrance of life. And who is equal to such a task?

Prayer: Lord, help me to be the aroma of Christ in my husband's life. Where I am "stinky," help me change. Fragrance my words and actions, Lord Jesus, so that my husband catches glimpses of you through me.

2 Corinthians 12:9

But he said to me, "My grace is sufficient for you, for my power is made perfect in weakness." Therefore I will boast all the more gladly about my weaknesses, so that Christ's power may rest on me.

Prayer: Lord, help me to rely on your strength and allow you to work through my weaknesses to make me stronger and to use those places in me to reach my husband as well. Help me to live my faith authentically so that my actions will be a loud testimony to my husband of your saving grace.

2 Timothy 1:7

For God did not give us a spirit of timidity, but a spirit of power, of love and of self-discipline.

Prayer: Thank you, Lord, that you did not give me a fearful spirit, but one steeped in your power, your love, and a sound mind. Help me to remember this truth whenever I am afraid, overwhelmed, or losing hope.

Romans 15:13
